



Hifz Tip: Recite Your Revision by Heart

A common question is how a student should read their new portion of the Qur'an.

Key Principle

Confidence is essential in memorisation.

Guidelines for Effective Recitation:

- A student who reads their Sabak fluently, confidently, loudly, and clearly with correct Tajweed, without mumbling or hesitation, is performing well. One or two minor mistakes are acceptable depending on the portion size
- Conversely, if a student mumbles, hesitates, reads quietly, or repeatedly goes back and forth, even without clear mistakes, this indicates the portion has not been fully memorised and is considered a fail.

Final Advice

The foundation of strong Hifz is clarity, confidence, and fluency rather than relying solely on mental correction.
