Key features of Hizbul Azam include:

- **Daily Sections:** The book is structured into seven distinct sections. This allows the reader to easily recite one section per day to complete the entire cycle over the course of a week.
- **Spiritual Significance:** Many traditional scholars and believers read it daily as a spiritual tool for protection, seeking closeness to Allah, and finding solace.
